Year End Trip	Capt Bejenaru	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The original approved budget of 15,000\$ was projected for a Quebec City Trip with visit to CFB Valcartier • Initial plan is not possible due to unavailability of facilities due to G7 preparations • Staff is proposing an alternative plan – 3 day trip to the Greater Toronto Area. Would leave Friday morning, visit RMC, Trenton, old Fort York then finish the day in Borden. Saturday would be a cadet day at Canada’s Wonderland, returning to Borden for the night. Sunday would start with a visit to the Ontario Science Museum and then back to Ottawa. The projected cost would total 27,000\$ (bus 10,000\$, accommodations would be nearly free, activities/entry fees 10,000\$, food 7000\$). To make up the increase in costs, would increase the use of MCP funds (8000\$) for transportation and propose a contribution of 100\$/cadet. • Committee would like to come back to this discussion to make a decision next Thursday.
